



Tuesday afternoons, arrival by 14.30pm, session starts at 14.45pm Refreshments are served before the session.



Behind The Scenes "The Journey of Delivering Joy"

A Special 'Thank You' to Dunelm champions Jenny and Steph for all their amazing work managing the Delivering Joy Campaign

A timeline showing the amount of work that was done in the months before Christmas:

July

• The first call took place with Age UK National in July to discuss Dunelm Delivering Joy Campaign and for all independent charities to compile their list and send back to them at the end of July.

August

Tags now ready for collection, Jenny, Dunelm champion details given for Radcliffe Store

September

• Christmas Tags to be completed by the 17th September, Steph arranged meeting with Jenny

October

 Steph met Jenny and had a detailed chat about all our services, original gift list we asked for was 27 for the Befriending Team, and during the meeting was asked to increase numbers which jumped to 150

November

• Some of the gifts are now ready for collection, Age UK staff Steph and David arrange to go to get them and meet Steph the other Champion for Dunelm

December

- Two more collections, the number of presents keep rising.
- 4th visit was advised to bring an empty van, we arrived and there were five full shopping trolleys with 103 Christmas Gifts
- · On the final delivery Steph and Casey delivered them, over 30 additional Christmas gifts.

In total a staggering 400 gifts were received by Age UK Bury.


MINIBUS DRIVERS REQUIRED


We are looking for Two volunteer minibus drivers
