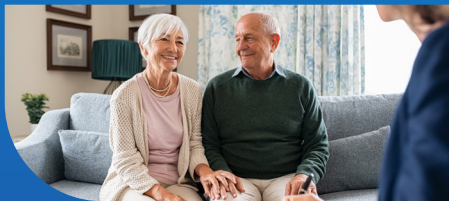

Our home Support Workers can help with household tasks such as cleaning, laundry, ironing, and shopping. To access this service - subject to availability - there is one off admin charge then we charge per hour.

Cambridgeshire Handyperson

For Who: Over 65's or any adult (18 or over) with a disability, whether short or long term.
Where: Cambridge City, South & East Cambs, Hunts and Fenland
Cost: Chargeable service

We support the prevention of falls and accidents in the home. We offer a free Personal Assessment and Home Safety Check to advise on aids, adaptations and grab rails. We support safe and timely Hospital Discharges with key safe and grab rail fitting, and bed/furniture moves. General DIY tasks, e.g. build flat pack furniture, put up blinds, curtain rails etc.
