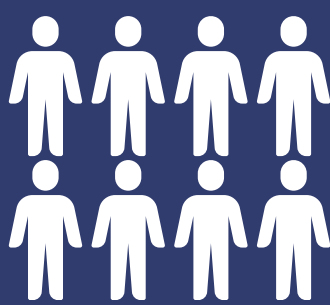

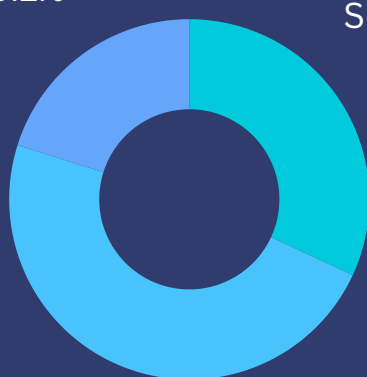

In this quarter, demand for our services has become varied, with many people requiring accessible, wheelchair-friendly transport solutions. Our Truro Electric Vehicle has seen demand increase considerably.

We have coordinated bookings for a wide range of reasons: helping people join Beach Cleans; Dementia Support Groups; local events and services; MS Society, Winter Fairs, local Community Hubs; and much more – all helping to improve wellbeing and reduce social isolation. In recent months, we have also supported Hospital and Home trips to help people return safely home from hospital and reduce re-admissions.
