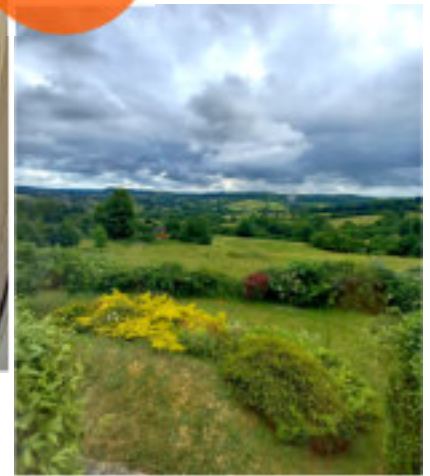


Opportunity 1 - Edge, GL6

The Opportunity
