- **Customer Service:** Provide friendly and courteous service to all customers and staff, acting as a representative of our Charity and maintaining a positive image
- **Compliance:** Adhere to all road safety regulations and organisational policies, including, lone working, health and safety regulations

- Good physical health, capable of lifting and carrying items
- Excellent time management and organisational skills
