What you will be doing:

- Occasionally (with the coordinator), accompany clients on trips and events that are outside of the club.
- To ensure the group is welcoming and fun to existing and new members
- To encourage group members to socialise and participate in activities
- To help in the setting up of rooms for activities, for example moving tables and chairs.
- Make tea and coffee, prepare light refreshments

What we are looking for:

- Experience of dealing with members of the public in a professional way
- Good interpersonal skills and be able to talk to a wide variety of people
- Empathy and an understanding of the issues that face older people
- Enthusiasm and reliability
- Other languages are an advantage

Time commitment:

A regular commitment for at least twelve months

Checks to be completed for role:

- 2 References will be required. One must be from a current/previous employer, tutor or volunteer manager who has known you for at least two years.
- Enhanced DBS Check, the cost of which will be covered by Age UK HHB
