By car: Take A315 Staines Road to Bedfont Lane traffic lights. Turn **left** into Bedfont Lane. Take 2nd turning on **right** into Southville Road, keep **left** on Southville Road until you reach the centre.

By bus: 116 from Hounslow alight at Bedfont Lane bus stop J. Walk down Bedfont Lane, 2nd right into Southville Road, keep left until you reach the Centre.
