

Crochet Bee Pattern



Materials:

- 4mm Hook
- Yarn Needle
- Scissors
- Yarn in Black, Yellow and White

Abbreviations:

- MR: magic ring
- Sc: single crochet
- Hdc: half double crochet
- Dc: double crochet
- St: stitch
- Dec: decrease*
- Inc: increase*

Body

Start with yellow yarn

1: 6 sc in MR (6)

2: Inc x 6 (12)

3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)

4: (sc, inc, sc) x 6 (24)

5: (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30)

6: (2 sc, inc, 2 sc) x 6 (36)

7-8: sc around (36)

Change to black yarn and sew the eyes on row 4, about 8 to 9 stitches apart

9-11: sc around (36) Change to yellow yarn

12-15: sc around (36) Change to black yarn

16-18: sc around Change to yellow yarn

19: (Sc 4, dec) x 6 (30)

20: (Sc 3, dec) x 6 (24)

21: (Sc 2, dec) x 6 (18)

Change to black yarn and start stuffing

22: (Sc, dec) x 6 (12)

23: Dec x 6 (6)

Finish stuffing, cut the yarn and pull the thread through the front loop of each stitch. Then, close the hole

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Wings (X2):

Use white yarn

1: 6 sc in MC

2: Inc x 6 (12)

3: Sc 3, (2 hdc in the same st) x 6, sc 3 (18)

4: Hdc 6, (2 dc in the same st) x 6, hdc 6 (24)

Finish off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Assembly

Place the wings after the first black stripe, about 4 stitches apart from each other. The "good" side should face outward.
