Information and Advice

Our dedicated advisers provide information and advice on a range of issues via our telephone advice line, website, email or in person.

Care Home Finder service

Provides accurate information for people considering a move into residential care either permanently, for respite or for day care. Our website is updated daily with vacancy details.

Benefits service

Provides practical help and advice about entitlements and benefits for older people and their carers.

Money Matters

Supports older people with the day to day management of household finances and paperwork.

Housing and Care Options

Offers a free consultation around your housing and care options, whether it is adapting your home or relocating.

In addition, we now offer a fees

based service which can provide you with a range of practical support.

Advocacy service

Provides independent advocates to help older people speak up for themselves and assert their rights when decisions are being made that affect their lives.

Lasting Power of Attorney (LPA) Advisory service

Offers advice regarding LPA. Trained advisers can assist with completing the forms and the registration process.

NHS Complaints Advocacy service

Offers practical support to those making, or thinking of making, a complaint about NHS services or treatment. This service is completely independent of the NHS.

'I have been a carer for my husband for several years and started to find it a struggle to push him in his wheelchair – particularly on and off the bus. We stopped going on outings as the thought of the difficulties of getting him around would make me so anxious.
