Are you struggling to enjoy your later life? Are you lonely? Would you value advice or assistance to help you connect with people in your local community?

The Age UK Notts Health & Wellbeing services can support you to find solutions that will help you to remain independent and get the most out of later life. Whether it's housing, health, finance, loneliness or care needs, we can work with you.

Our staff and volunteers will put your needs, wishes & priorities at the centre of what they do. They will point you to local activities and services or, should you need it, they can work with you to put a plan in place to improve your life.

We can offer various types of support in different areas of the city and county.

- The Connect team will support adults 18+ living in Mid
 Nottinghamshire and South Nottinghamshire who feel they have
 deteriorating independence or health through age, mobility,
 physical disability, learning disability, Neuro-diverse conditions, long
 term health conditions or bereavement.
- We can help you combat loneliness by linking you up with a Companion Service Volunteer or a Volunteer Telephone Companion.
- If you would like to learn to use a computer or tablet, you can now do this through our Companion service.















Our Services cont.

We can provide access to a range of activities such as:

- Best Foot Forward walks, which are free guided health walks that take place in various areas of the city and county.
- Men in Sheds, which offers older men the opportunity to make friends over woodworking activities at a 'shed' in Worksop, Daybrook or Blidworth.
- We can provide details on a whole host of other activities organised by local organisations across the county.

If you would like to use your talent and skills to improve the quality of life of older people, then why not volunteer with us? There are many ways to get involved; for example, become an at home volunteer in our Companion Service to help relieve loneliness; supporting older people with dementia at our specialist day service, fundraising for us or helping in our Charity shop in Sutton in Ashfield.

We can provide access to Age UK Notts specialist teams who can provide advice, advocacy, housing, and dementia support services.

- Nottingham City care homes and anyone registered with a City GP resident in a county care home.



















The Age UK Business Directory

Best Foot Forward Walking Groups

Free guided health walks around various areas in Nottingham. Best Foot Forward walks are led by trained walk leaders, one who leads from the front and the other who follows at the back of the group.

Walks are FREE and everyone is welcome, though we ask that people under the age of 18 are accompanied by an adult.

We have over 10 Walks taking place across the City & County.

Our Gentle Walk & Talks are slower paced and are aimed at people who are wanting to become more mobile and may struggle with long term health conditions, who would like to meet new friends.

We also have a Veterans Camaraderie Walk at Kingsmill Reservoir.






Housing

Our specialist Safe & Sound team helps adults living across Nottinghamshire to stay safe, warm and independent in their own homes.

Our Safe & Sound team can provide:

- Help with heating problems, boiler replacements and repairs.
- Short term oil filled radiator loan while your heating is restored.
- Free registry onto the Priority Services Register, so that you become a priority in the event of a power cut.
- Free Home Energy Checks including fitting of low cost energy saving devices such as radiator foils, LED lightbulbs and draught excluders.
- Free energy saving advice and information.

























Information, Signposting and Advice

- A free Age UK Notts Business Directory with older peoples' needs at its heart. The Business Directory consists of reputable and trustworthy member companies ranging from plumbers to solicitors. All member companies have been checked by our staff to give you peace of mind.




Scams Awareness


