

Grants information sheet

Grants may be available those on a low income who need help with a one-off expense or short-term general living costs. Age UK Wiltshire don't generally offer grants but we can help you to apply. Grants don't need to be paid back.

General criteria

- Usually you need to be in receipt of a means-tested benefit, or in the process of applying for one.
- Grants are not paid retrospectively. A grant must be awarded before work is undertaken or item is purchased.
- Usually 2 quotes for work or evidence of the cost of an item are required to accompany a grant application.
- Evidence of low income (bank statements, benefit letters) is required to accompany a grant application
- A benefits check is completed to ensure you are maximising your income.

General grants

- Friends of the Elderly offer grants to people over pensionage of up to approx £300 for essential household items, unexpected bills and digital technology items.
- Occupational / health charity grants are available to help retired and current employees of certain professions e.g. SSAFA, Cavell Nurses Trust, plus for informal carers and some specific health conditions. This may be applicable to the client and/or their partner.

Boiler/heating system repairs or replacement:

- The Environment Centre (tEC) offer free energy advice tel: 0800 804 8601
- Age UK Southampton 'Spread the Warmth' leaflet has grants, schemes and relevant local organisations listed.
- Check if you're entitled to **Warm Home Discount** from your electricity supplier.
- Contact your supplier to ask about grants.

White goods, furniture and housing costs

- Local authorities have local welfare provision for urgent emergencies e.g. supermarket gift cards, white goods, pre-payment meter cards. Contact your local council for details.
- Local authorities may have funding for rent deposit schemes to help people with costs of moving into private rented property – contact your local council.
- Local **furniture re-use charities** offer low-cost items (sometimes free!) to those on a low income.

Home adaptations, equipment and repairs

- You can request a free care needs assessment from your Local Authority adult social care team. This could result in up to £1000 of free aids/equipment and/or a means-tested Disabled Facilities Grant for larger adaptations e.g. wet room or stairlift. (FS42)
- Local authorities may offer subsidised loans or grants in exceptional cases. Contact the 'private sector housing renewal' team at your local council.

What other money could you be entitled to?

- You may qualify for help with NHS health costs (NHS Low Income Scheme tel: 0300 330 1343).
- There may be discounts on your utility bills if you are on a low income, or you could switch supplier.
- If you have debts, seek free debt advice to help (IG57).
- A free benefits check will ensure you are maximising your entitlement to welfare benefits
