AUKWSBH require Home Help staff for cleaning, household tasks and shopping.

The service focusses on assisting older people to allow them to remain independent in their own homes. Work hours are flexible and according to your availability.

Hourly rates are £13.50 to £16.50 (dependent on area) on a self-employed basis. All applicants will be DBS checked through AUKWSBH. Training and ongoing support will be provided.
